

We're now halfway through the year and there has been lots of great work going on.

Safety wise, we're continuing to make excellent progress. We've set another 30% reduction target for the year (on the back of last year's excellent safety performance) and have already reduced our TRIFR (Total Reportable Injury Frequency Rate) to 14.8, down from 49.3 this time last year. Since 31 March, we have reduced our TRIFR by an encouraging 18%.

While not picking up the award, I was really thrilled to be named as a finalist for the Health & Safety Executive of the Year at the New Zealand Safeguard Health & Safety awards. It was a great night and amazing to see all of the initiatives that are taking place in safety and wellbeing across such a wide range of businesses. We've made incredible progress ourselves, so I'd like to thank the whole Treescape® team for committing to make real and positive change in how we approach safety and wellbeing.

There's a piece on Green Asset Management, what it is and why it matters, and some great examples of stewardship (kaitiakitanga) with our teams in Canberra and Waiheke, where we have gone above and beyond to protect our natural wildlife.

We're continuing to do great things in our community, and it was great to see some of our Auckland team seeking out arborists of the future at the Manurewa High School Careers day, as well as a huge team of Treescapers (from Operations and the Head Office) assisting Vector and 2 other companies to plant 15,000 plants and trees at Totara Park in Manurewa. All just part of helping to foster a better, greener world for future generations.
